## Association News:

**2020 Officer Election:** The process for 2020 elections has started. Your board has proposed a slate (see below) and has announced it at the general meeting on 9/11/19. **November Meeting:** Will be on 13 November at the clubhouse at 7PM. We have already tabled two items that will be voted upon: The Revised CYPT Constitution and the 2020 Budget (estimated). Both of these items are attached for your review. We will need a vote of 2/3rds of the quorum of 20 to be able to put these two items into effect. It's my intention to follow this basic timeline in future years (table in September, vote in November, effect January 1).

**Audit and Assistance:** Another upcoming annual event will be an audit of the association's financial records in January with report out to the association at the February meeting. This year we are looking at some assistance from outside professionals concerning the audit and some other financial/legal advice. More on this at the November meeting.
